Construction:

Multihull made in polyester, standard Nautitech 435, built in 1996, by Dufour and Sparks, designed by the architects Mortain/Mavrikios. The boat was built at the request of a private individual, thus equipped with completions "owners". Her plan of installation is however that of a charter version (4 cabins, 4 bathrooms).

The boat was never rented and scrupulously maintained by her preceding owner.

The boat was bought in 2007 in the Antilles, by her current owners for a great trip with their children.

She then was entirely re-checked (rigging, engines) and was maintained (rudder, wicks,...). Many technical improvements were made (reinforcements, insulation of the refrigerator, evacuation trunks,...).

Installations:

8 beds,

2 large double back cabins with berth widthwise, (slatted bedspring).

2 front double cabins, berth lengthwise.

4 bathrooms/WC with shower.

A very big saloon with a fold-down table

A U-shaped galley with a sliding food hatch between galley and cockpit..

A chart table.

A very large cockpit with fixed table and removable reduction.

2 compartments in the front peaks accessible from the inside

Many external storage lockers

Engine:

2 engines inboard Volvo 2030 of 28 PK each, (approximately 4000 hours) entirely revised in 2008 by Volvo Marine. 2 gasoil reserves of 150 liters each(300 liters on the whole) + a reserve of 260 liters out of jerry can.

Rigging:

Mainsail: North Sails 2003 revised in 2008 and 2009, with lazy bag.

Winding Genoa, 2008, (spare genoa in good state).

Booster rocket, (double gennacker), on roller fixed on jibboom.

Storm jib

Dead rigging revised in 2007 (stay and main shrowd changed in 2003).

Running rigging entirely changed 2008.

Electric windlass Lofran.

Main mooring: CQR of 25 kg with 100 meters of chain of 10 (2008). Secondary mooring: FOB anchors of 25 kg with 100 meters of hawsers.

Double sink with tap for fresh drinking water with filtration system.

Danfoss refrigerator cooled with sea water (2008),

Danfoss freezer cooled with sea water (2005 -circulating pump changed in 2008, + spare pump).

Water heater engine/220 V (in all the bathrooms and kitchen).

Air-conditioning (hot/cold) with circulation (one block per cabin).

12 V ventilators (one per cabin).

Complete Hifi, TV aerial and audiovisual pre-installation.

Sea Recovery Aqua Whisper 450 desalter (70 liters/hour) 2009, (upgrade to 140 if needed).
